### **AN INNOVATION in FOOD TECHNOLOGY: CHEESE MAKING FOR SENIOR STUDENTS**

In this two day course with Australian renowned Master Cheesemaker, Graham Redhead from Queensland, you will learn to make 3 - 4 cheeses, prepare stone ground flour into a simple pizza dough and create appetizing toppings, using local in-season ingredients.

The practical workshop will teach you how to make cheese, give you the confidence to teach others and go away with a lesson booklet for your classes. The lesson activities will be aimed at meeting the achievement standards of the Australian Curriculum Design and Technologies: Food and fibre production classes or Food specialisation electives.

The cost is \$350.00 per participant. All equipment and ingredients provided.

Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea provided during the course.

#### **TIMES:**

Day ONE 10.00am – 4.00pm

Day TWO 8.00am – 12.00 noon

**Day One:** Theory and induction into the Art of Cheesemaking with an **emphasis on teaching to high school students** or those studying Agricultural Studies as part of the Australian Curriculum, Design and Technologies - Food and Fibre Production. Cheeses to be created include Feta, Ricotta, Mozzarella.

**Day Two:** follow the sovereignty of your food and create a “field to fork product”, making your own locally milled flour into a pizza base, utilize fresh in-season local ingredients for a fresh tomato sauce (or similar) and top with your hand crafted fresh cheese.

Opportunities for socialising at a Hobart restaurant is an evening option for Thursday.
